**Board Composition:** Board of licensed geologists (includes State Geologist) and one professional community representative at large. The Board is appointed by the governor to serve four year terms.

---

**Requirements:**

Education: Completion of at least 30 semester hours or 45 quarter hours culminating in a Baccalaureate or an advanced degree in geosciences.

Experience: Applicants must meet one of the following criteria: Five years of teaching geology as a faculty member at the college or university level; five years of geological research by an applicant at the college or university level; five years of geological work performed under the supervision of, or in collaboration with, a licensed professional geologist; seven years of geological work that is acceptable to the Board.

Examination: ASBOG®

First ASBOG® Exam: March 1999

Continuing Education: On March 14, 2022, Governor Eric Holcomb signed Senate Bill 278 into Public Law 108 that included adding Continuing Education to the Indiana Licensure for Professional Geologists program. The law went into effect on July 1, 2022. The Board has until July 1, 2024 to implement the CE requirements. All reviews will start after July 1, 2025.
